



DOCK RULES

USE OF THE DOCK IS AT YOUR OWN RISK

RULES:

1. Use of the docks is restricted to Sweetwater residents and homeowners and their invited guests.
2. No swimming, diving or jumping from the docks.
3. No running, climbing or horseplay is permitted on the docks.
4. No loud music is permitted on the docks.
5. Sitting on the dock's handrails is prohibited.
6. No grills, firearms, fireworks or dangerous projectiles are permitted on the docks.
7. Sweetwater residents, homeowners and guests under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times on the docks.
8. Toddlers and non-swimmers must wear life jackets on the docks.
9. All trash must properly be disposed of.
10. Pets must be leashed at all times on the docks.
11. No fishing, crabbing or throwing cast nets where posted "No Fishing".
12. Cutting bait on the dock's handrails is prohibited.
13. Cleaning fish on the docks is prohibited.
14. State and federal rules must be followed when fishing.
15. Promptly notify the property manager of any unsafe or hazardous conditions.
16. Boat slips shall not be occupied before the property manager authorizes it.
17. No wake. Idling speed must be maintained when leaving or approaching the docks.
18. Follow all the Boater Safety Rules & Regulations of the U.S. Coast Guard for boating.
